

## WATCH D.O.G.S. INSTRUCTIONS

### Orientation

- > Park in visitor spot in the front circle drive nearby.
- > Sign in with office staff (you will need ID) and receive school badge to be worn during your volunteer day.
- > Steve Kowalski (AP) will be your contact person should you have any questions.

# Car Duty

- Welcome students as car greeter in the AM and assist with car rider dismissal during PM.
- > The staff members who are also there to assist will give your guidance.
- For safety reasons, your child may not assist you. Your student will go to their assigned location in the school.

# Announcements

You and your child's name will be announced on the morning announcements. After announcements, stick around for a quick photo with your child.

#### Classroom Visits

- You will be scheduled to visit multiple classrooms. Remember you are volunteering to be a positive male role model for all the students.
- > Classroom teachers will provide direction on how to assist and actively engage students.

#### Rotation

- > You will go with your student to most of their classes but will also participate in other duties around the campus.
- > If you have multiple students, you will be assigned a rotation schedule to ensure time with all of your children.

### Lunch Duty

- > Mr. Kowalski or the other staff members on lunch duty will provide guidance on how to help.
- You likely will be asked to assist students with opening food items, handing out napkins, condiments, utensils, or cleaning tables.
- ➤ Please assist with all grade level lunch tables.
- > Your lunch time will be with your student. Please, sit with your student and their class during your lunch break.
- > School lunches are \$5.00, school policy does not allow you to use your child's lunch account to purchase your food.

## Restroom Breaks

Adult restrooms are in the front office area near the copy machine.

## Breaks

If you need a moment or two to relax, use the restroom, or need a break, feel free to take a few minutes in the staff lounge.

# Recess Duty

- > Help keep order on the playground.
- > Do not push other students down the slides, assist with monkey bars/climbing toys, etc.

### Reminders

Per district and/or Watch DOGS guidelines, you may not go into student restrooms, be alone or unsupervised with a student, espouse political or religious beliefs to students, or smoke on campus.
