# What is Dual Credit?

Dual Credit is a process by which a
high school student enrolls in a
college course and receives academic
or workforce credit for the course
from both the college and the high
school at the same time.

#### **FERPA**

FERPA affords students in "attendance" at Houston Community College certain rights with respect to their education records.

#### **FERPA Waiver Form**

FERPA is a federal law that governs privacy of and access to personally identifiable student records. Instructors will only communicate with the student about their grade status and not the parent. Parents should communicate with their student about academic progress.

Students must communicate with the instructor

College Faculty will **NOT** communicate with parents about the college grade

If a parent has a concern, they can reach out to their high school administration who will facilitate communication with the college

#### **Student Expectations**



In all matters related to the dual credit course, students are held to the standards, expectations and regulations of HCC.


- 1. Academic standards
- 2. Attendance requirements
- 3. Grading procedures
- 4. Discipline procedures (including appeals)

#### Attendance Requirements

HCC does not differentiate between unexcused and excused absences.

- 1. KISD field trips count as absences.
- 2. Student can be dropped for excessive absences (more than 6).
- 3. Student is responsible for make-up work.
- 4. Specific Meetings times and days vary by campus.

#### **Grading Policies**



- Progress reports and report card grades are NOT issued during the semester.
- Instructors will ONLY communicate with the student (not the parent/guardian) about his/her course grades.
- Dual credit courses are exempt from UIL eligibility rules.
- Dual credit courses receive a weighted grade point of 4.5 for determining high school GPA.
- KISD final exam exemptions are not available for HCC dual credit courses.

There are no final exam exemptions for dual credit. All students must take the final.

KISD disciplinary infractions may impact dual credit attendance.


Students may be administratively withdrawn for inappropriate behavior and attendance.

## The process: Returning Students

- Step 1: Fill out Jordans Dual Credit Form and ensure you have met the requirements to take the course.
- Step 2: If needed, take the TSIA
- Step 3: HCC will enroll students based on the high school roster as we return to school.
- Step 4: Payment

#### The process: New Students

- Step 1 : Apply to HCC through ApplyTX as a **DUAL CREDIT STUDENT**
- Step 2: Submit <u>HCC PAPERWORK</u> via JHS DUAL CREDIT SUBMISSION FORM
- Step 3: TSIA Assessment for those who do not qualify via test scores
- Step 4: HCC will enroll students based on the high school roster as we return to school.
- Step 5: Payment
