- 5. Course verification will take place March 8-18.




ACADEMIC COURSESon grade level and designed to prepare students for high school and college.

KAP COURSES

(Katy Advanced Placement)prepare students for Advanced Placement courses (college-level instruction) while in high school.

KAP PROGRAM

A "A" average in the academic class, or a "B" in the KAP class, is a good indicator of future success in a KAP class. KAP courses are designed to challenge motivated students and prepare them for success in advanced coursework. The courses:

- typically move at a faster pace,
- are academically challenging,
- require more independent learning

KAP PROGRAM INFORMATIO N

Students may exit a KAP course during the first 6-weeks grading period or at the end of the 1st semester.

The student must have teacher and parent approval to exit.


If the student's 6-weeks average falls below 70, it is recommended to exit the class at the end of the grading period.

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT ELECTIVES

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT COURSES

- High School Credit classes will go on a High School Transcript. A high school transcript will impact the rest of your educational career.
 - GPA (Grade Point Average)
 - Class rank
 - Colleges first snapshot of you

You will take a midterm and final exam.

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT COURSES

- Students may only **REQUEST** to <u>exit</u> a HS credit course through the **end of the 1st grading period**.
- Students who earn an "F" at the end of the first or second grading period in a HS credit course will be automatically removed unless recommended by the teacher and administrator.
- Students who earn a first semester failing grade will have the grade recorded on their transcript, and will be removed from the course for the second semester.
- Students will **NOT** have an opportunity to drop the HS credit course during the second semester.

OTHER COURSES

Students who do not pass the Math or Reading section of the STAAR test will be placed in these courses instead of the elective choice.



MATH LAB

is designed to help refine and review math skills in preparation for the STAAR test.

READING ELECTIVE

is designed to help improve reading level and basic reading skills in preparation for the STAAR test.

COURSE VERIFICATION

The Course Verification window is from March 8 - March 18. Students and parents are able to verify and submit course change requests in SchooLinks.

Parents will receive an email after March 7th with a link to verify courses.
