Katy ISD partnerships are reciprocal, long-term, mutually beneficial relationships between a business and a campus.

The primary focus of all partnerships is human resource involvement through initiatives such as the KEYS mentor program, Junior Achievement, Promise to Read or other campus-specific activities.

Partnerships are managed by the campus PIE Liaison in cooperation with the Partners in Education department. Conversely, businesses designate someone to work directly with the campus liaison.
