APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The Katy Area Retired Educators Scholarship is available to a 2024 graduating senior in Katy ISD. The Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- > Demonstrated financial need. (would be referenced in essay, or family information)
- Clearly defined career goal in education for teaching grades K 12, please note what grade level(s) or subject(s) the applicant plans to teach.
- Typed essay (1 page) describing what has inspired the applicant to want to teach and why applicant thinks he/she would be a worthy recipient of the scholarship.

Other considerations include:

- > Community involvement, extracurricular activities, work experience
- > Letters of recommendation pertaining to your potential success while working with students/youth
 - One (1) letter from a teacher
 - A second letter from a community leader, counselor, pastor, employer, or different teacher, etc.
- > Overall GPA of at least 3.0 on a weighted scale (copy of transcript <u>must</u> be included)

Overview of the K.A.R.E. Scholarship application process:

- Scholarship will be in the amount of \$1200.00 and awarded based on criteria and considerations listed above.
- Scholarship winner will be notified by phone/email by a member of the KARE Scholarship Committee.
- Payment of scholarship funds will be made directly to the recipient after the student shows proof of registration and receipt of payment at a U.S. college or university. Scholarship payment will be made for the Summer or Fall semester immediately following the student's high school graduation and details of the Scholarship payment process will be conveyed to the recipient after notification of his/her selection.
- All completed scholarship applications are due in the counselors' office by March 7, 2024, <u>OR</u> by the high school scholarship deadline, if earlier, set by the counselors' office at the applicant's school, whichever is earlier.
- The Katy ISD College and Career Specialist will pick up all completed applications on March 8, 2024.
- Students selected as recipients of the K.A.R.E. Scholarship <u>are expected to</u> <u>attend a recognition luncheon on Wednesday, May 8, 2024.</u> In addition to the recipient attending, it is requested that the student's parent(s)/guardian(s), school counselor, and if available, a campus principal attend with the student.
