When a Parent/Guardian or Student logs into HAC -

In the Section after the display of courses, the Student's most recently calculated Weighted and Unweighted GPA's will display. In this section, the student's Rank and Quartile will also display after the student has completed Semester 1 of their 11th grade Year.







*Class Rank Calculation is run in January, after Semester 1 and June, after Semester 2






