What is Canvas?

Canvas is a learning management system (LMS) that allows teachers to provide instructional support, class calendars, assignments, and resources for students in a safe, online environment.



How do Parents sign in?

Begin by logging into [My Katy Cloud](#). Search for Canvas using the search tool at the top-left. Click the Canvas tile and sign in using your Home Access Center username and password. You may [reset your password](#) by checking the "Additional Links" section on the MyKaty Cloud login page.



Update Your Notification Preferences

Notification settings allow you to receive announcements, receive information about course activities, have messages from Canvas sent to your email, and more. Update how frequently you would like to be notified.

Check Your Student's Calendar

By accessing the calendar, you can view everything your student has to do for their courses. View by week, month or Agenda view. Filter the calendar by clicking the color box next to the calendar course name.
